Speaking from the Vatican balcony just after being unveiled as the new pontiff, Pope Leo XIV paid tribute to his predecessor and called for unity. Robert Prevost, 69, was chosen following a two-day conclave in Vatican City, and is the first American to lead the Catholic Church.

"Help us, and help each other, build bridges," he told the crowd of more than 40,000 people in St Peter's Square.

VILLANOVA, Pa. (WPVI) -- American Cardinal Robert Prevost, now named Pope Leo XIV, has a strong tie to the Philadelphia region. Prevost, a 69-year-old from Chicago, graduated from Villanova University in Delaware County, Pennsylvania, with a Bachelor of Science degree in mathematics in 1977. Founded in 1842, Villanova University is one of only two Augustinian Catholic institutions of higher learning in the United States, [the university said](#)". Prevost was twice elected prior general, or top leader, of the Augustinians, a 13th century religious order founded by St. Augustine.

He has spent a majority of his time in Peru, where he has also worked as a teacher, missionary and parish priest. He received priestly ordination on June 19, 1982, after studying canon law at the Pontifical Saint Thomas Aquinas University, according to his [bio on the Vatican Press website](#).
