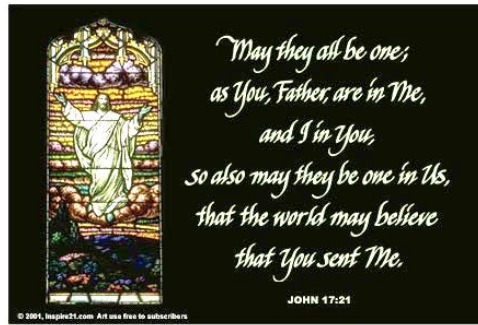

**Violence against Christians is a rising worldwide phenomenon.**

An independent review estimates that one in three people suffer religious persecution. Christians are by far the most likely to be targeted. The report notes that the Christian faith risks disappearing from the Middle East. - "In Palestine Christian numbers are below 1.5 %; in Syria the Christian population has declined from 1.7million in 2011 to below 450,000; and in Iraq, numbers have slumped from 1.5million before 2003 to below 120,000 today."
