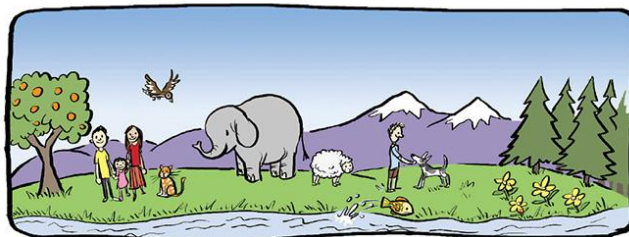

**Caring for Creation – thoughts from CAFOD's 'Live Simply' book:**

A thoughtful Christian understanding of God's creation and our place in it helps us to see how to respond to its needs. We need to get our facts right, and we need to study our own rich Christian tradition to understand why this is an issue for us to address.

First of all though, what is needed is a change of heart, a shift in attitude, an inner realisation or clearing of perception. The biggest obstacle to true perception and sincere response is self-interest, born of fear and desire. These are hardly gospel imperatives.
