Mass

Mass Times

Saturday Vigil 5.00 pm

Sunday 9.30 am

For the safety of all, those attending must:

Remain 2 metres apart.

Sanitise hands on entering and exiting the Church.

Follow the signs.

Listen to the stewards.

Holy Communion: should be received on the palm of the hand only. With outstretched arms one hand on top of the other.

Receive in silence.

The Church will be disinfected after each Liturgy.

Please take your Mass sheet home with you.

During Mass there will be no:

Altar servers
Children's liturgy
Eucharistic ministers
Offertory procession
Physical sign of peace
Chalice distribution
Parish missals or hymn books
Singing
Collection baskets
Congregating outside
(A steward will dispense Hand Sanitiser into your palm as you exit)

It is very important that you stay home if:

You may have a pre-existing condition or are immuno-compromised

You are feeling unwell

You suspect you may be ill or have been exposed to Covid -19

You have a sick family member at home

Toilets are to remain closed and locked.

If using the **Car Park** please try to leave an empty space between each car if at all possible.
