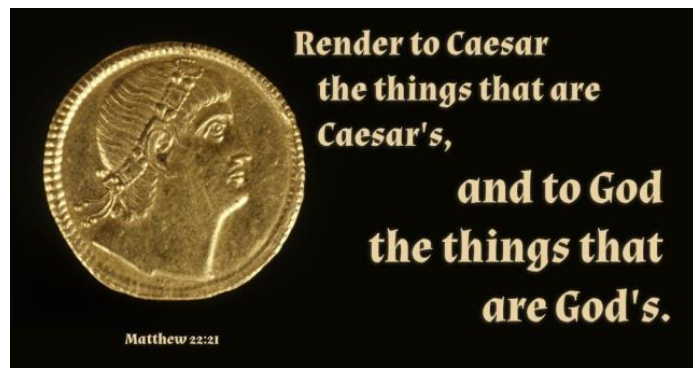

The Archdiocese does however highlight that a standing order remains the most cost effective way for parishioners to donate.
