Parish Donations and Upkeep

<u>On Line Donations</u>: The Archdiocese has now set up a system for individuals to continue to donate to the church during this unprecedented time. There is a donate button (top right) on the home page of the diocesan website – <u>www.birminghamdiocese.org.uk</u> From there donations which can also be gift aided can be made to any parish via credit or debit card.

There are transaction charges levied by the card processing company which amount to 20p + 1.9% of the value of the donation – so for a £10 donation this will amount to £0.39 which will be deducted from the amount we receive. The Archdiocese does however highlight that a standing order remains the most cost effective way for parishioners to donate. (*Easter and Christmas Offerings to the Clergy does not apply*).

In addition, any donations put through the presbytery letterbox will be more than welcome to help with the upkeep of the church.
